## Assisted Review

Relativity is the e-discovery review software that amplifies the efforts of a case team through computer-assisted review.

### Overview

Relativity Assisted Review is a faster, more accurate way to review large volumes of electronic documents. It combines technology and process, making use of Relativity's text analytics engine to code statistically sampled subsets of documents. Based on user coding decisions, Relativity will build a list of documents that are highly similar.

This grouping of documents runs behind-the-scenes, so reviewers can continue to code documents the same way they always have, while increasing speed and improving accuracy. Relativity uses the expertise of these reviewers to magnify the case team's efforts and make decisions on the rest of the documents in a collection. Users can then prioritize the relevant documents and ignore large groups of non-responsive material.

### Iterative Process

Once Relativity has classified a collection of documents based on a review team's decisions, administrators can QC Relativity's work, either agreeing with Relativity or changing the decision. Relativity will learn from this input to get smarter and improve results.

Assisted Review incorporates reporting tools to gauge progress, revealing how accurate Relativity has been to see if further iterations are necessary. Since batches of documents coded by Relativity are randomly sampled using statistical analysis, you can be confident in evaluating the computer's accuracy and deciding when to stop manual review. In the end, Assisted Review allows users to discover the facts of the case earlier than with a standard review process, saving significant review costs.

### What does Assisted Review look like?

Relativity Assisted Review helps case teams work smarter and go faster by applying text analytics technology to their existing review process. Review teams begin by subjectively coding documents as responsive or non-responsive. After a statistical sample of documents has been coded, Relativity will determine how the rest of the documents in a case should be coded.

Nothing looks different for review teams, as Relativity works in the background while they continue making decisions.
